

\$50,000 Amateur Futurity

Rules and Regulations

2009

1. For three-year-olds (foals of 2006) all breeds. All entrants must be designated a \$50,000 Amateur by NCHA rules and records. The go round Trials for the \$200,000 Limited Non Pro and \$50,000 Amateur Divisions shall be drawn and worked together. An Amateur so qualifying for both divisions may enter both divisions, but shall pay no cattle charge for the second division entered.
2. \$5,000 added purse.
3. Nomination fee: If entering the Futurity Non-Pro division.
Payment Due Sept 10, 2009 *\$650
*includes \$338 Entry Fee, \$173 cattle charge, \$112 P/C**, \$12 video charge, \$5 Drug Fee & \$10 Turnback Stall Fee.
Nomination fee if you are not entering the Futurity Non Pro division.
Payment Due Sept 10, 2009. *\$850
*includes \$488 Entry Fee, \$173 cattle charge, \$162 P/C**, \$12 video chg, \$5 Drug Fee & \$10 Turnback Stall Fee. Late fees will apply.
4. There will be a \$50,000 Amateur Senior Jackpot (55 yrs and over).
Payment Due Sept 10, 2009.....*\$500
(\$400 jackpot/\$100.00 office charge)
It will be a class within the \$50,000 Amateur division. Payout will be according to the NCHA Payout Schedule based on order of advancement.
5. Entries are taken and processed per PCCHA Aged Event Entry Rules.
6. The \$50,000 Amateur Futurity will be one go and a finals. The top scoring 20% (with a minimum of 10) will advance to the finals. **Horses that mark a 0 or a 180 will not advance to the finals.** All horses will go clean to the finals.
7. Three (3) head of cattle will be used in the go-round and four (4) in the finals.
8. If there are any ties for the championship of a Pacific Coast Event, the purse will be distributed 50/50. A work off will be held *only* to determine the recipient of the awards, if the competitors should chose.
9. Vogt Buckles will be awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion.
10. The PCCHA Executive Committee reserves the right should it be deemed necessary, to make any changes or alterations to the above rules.
11. All Owners and Riders must be current members of PCCHA and NCHA to compete.
