Create and implement scholarship guidelines as approved by PCCHA Youth Fund, Inc., Board of Directors. Advise and assist PCCHA Youth Fund, Inc., conduct the Youth Auction and the implementation of the Youth Fundraising events. Review applications and provide its recommendations to the PCCHA Youth Fund Board for the annual Inez Mabie scholarship awards. Youth Committee Chairperson shall also serve as the chairperson of the PCCHA Youth Fund, Inc.

## **PCCHA 2010 Youth Scholarship Awards:**

### **1. PASO ROBLES DERBY & PCCHA SUMMER CIRCUIT**

Senior youth:        1<sup>st</sup> Place-\$1,000 scholarship  
                              2<sup>nd</sup> Place- \$500 scholarship  
                              3<sup>rd</sup> Place- \$250 scholarship  
                              4<sup>th</sup> Place- \$200 scholarship

Junior youth:        1<sup>st</sup> Place-\$1,000 scholarship  
                              2<sup>nd</sup> Place- \$500 scholarship  
                              3<sup>rd</sup> Place- \$250 scholarship  
                              4<sup>th</sup> Place- \$200 scholarship

TOTAL PLEDGE: \$7,800 (\$3,900 per show), 3 Invitational  
qualifying slots per division, per show. Total (12)

### **2. PCCHA YOUTH DAY #1 and #2:**

Senior youth:        1<sup>st</sup> Place- \$300 scholarship  
                              2<sup>nd</sup> Place- \$175 scholarship  
                              3<sup>rd</sup> Place- \$75 scholarship  
                              4<sup>th</sup> Place- \$50 scholarship

Junior youth:        1<sup>st</sup> Place- \$300 scholarship  
                              2<sup>nd</sup> Place- \$175 scholarship  
                              3<sup>rd</sup> Place- \$75 scholarship  
                              4<sup>th</sup> Place- \$50 scholarship

TOTAL PLEDGE: \$2,400 (\$1,200 per show)  
3 invitational qualifying slots per division,per show. Total(12)

### **3. “PCCHA Best of the West Youth Invitational” Cutting:**

Conduct the “PCCHA Best of the West Youth Invitational” Cutting during the PCCHA Futurity.

Separate Junior and Senior classes.

Provide 15 qualifying opportunities in both the Senior and Junior classes (total of 30) as follows:

A. PCCHA DERBY-MARCH 2010

First through third places plus ties in Junior and Senior  
(6 slots)

B. PCCHA Summer Circuit Cutting- June 2010

First through third places plus ties in Junior and Senior  
(6 slots)

C. PCCHA YOUTH DAYS #1 & #2: Date for 2010: TBD

First through third places plus ties in Junior and Senior (12  
slots)

D. PCCHA Vogt Top Ten (as of October 1<sup>st</sup> of current year):

Top three positions in both Junior and Senior standings.  
(6 slots)

E. In the event of positions open due to “duplicate qualifying” or “qualifiers that decline to compete at the Invitational”, those positions may be filled with competitors who placed in the following shows up to 4<sup>th</sup> place; or are listed in the PCCHA Year-End standings up to 10<sup>th</sup> place as of October 1<sup>st</sup> of current year.

Open positions will be filled in the following order:

- i. Take the next eligible competitor(s) in the PCCHA year-end standings to 5<sup>th</sup> place.
- ii. Take the 4<sup>th</sup> place competitor at Paso Robles Derby
- iii. Take the 4<sup>th</sup> place competitor at PCCHA Summer Circuit Cutting
- iv. Take the 4<sup>th</sup> place competitor at the PCCHA YOUTH DAY Show#1&#2

- v. Take the next eligible competitor(s) in the PCCHA Vogt Top Ten Standings up to 10<sup>th</sup> place.

Qualifying competitors must have a permanent residence within the PCCHA region, and be a member of PCCHA.

F. PCCHA Best of the West Youth Invitational: Scholarship Cutting pay-out:

Senior youth:            1<sup>st</sup> Place-\$2,000 scholarship  
                                  2<sup>nd</sup> Place-\$1,500 scholarship  
                                  3<sup>rd</sup> Place-\$1,000 scholarship  
                                  4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup>     \$500 each  
                                  7<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup>    \$250 each

Junior youth:            1<sup>st</sup> Place-\$2,000 scholarship  
                                  2<sup>nd</sup> Place-\$1,500 scholarship  
                                  3<sup>rd</sup> Place-\$1,000 scholarship  
                                  4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup>     \$500 each  
                                  7<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup>    \$250 each

In the event, there are less than 15 competitors, the 4<sup>th</sup> thru final placing scholarship monies will be prorated accordingly to a total of \$8500 purse per division. \*Qualifying language TBD.

G. The aprox. \$1,500 (\$500 per event) to cover reimbursement to the PCCHA for fresh cattle charges (hard costs) for the 2 Pacific Coast Qualifying events, and the Invitational event are to be prorated into the Youth entry fees, estimated cost @ \$25 per entry if a donor is not found to cover the costs of fresh cattle.

Total Pledge: \$16,500

**4. PCCHA 2010-YEAR END STANDINGS SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:**

Senior Youth Standings: 1<sup>st</sup> Place- \$1,500  
                                  2<sup>nd</sup> Place-\$1,000  
                                  3<sup>rd</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup>- \$500 each

Junior Youth Standings: 1<sup>st</sup> Place-\$1,500  
                                  2<sup>nd</sup> Place- \$1,000  
                                  3<sup>rd</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup>- \$500 each

TOTAL PLEDGE: \$13,000

**5. YOUTH CLINICS:**

Conduct a minimum of one youth clinics in the PCCHA region. The current budget is \$3,000 per clinic, (Not to exceed \$100 per Youth Cutter for 1 day clinics, or 150.00 per Youth Cutter on multiple day clinics) total annual budget not to exceed \$3,000. In the event the clinic does not meet the \$3,000 per clinic budget, then additional clinics may be held with the excess funds. Dates and locations **TBD**.

**6. FUNDRAISING EVENTS:**

PCCHA Scholarship Fund Raising:

- A. A: The annual auction in March, 2010 at a TBD- Location Paso Robles, during the PCCHA Derby in conjunction with the Trainers Dinner. The Youth Auction Chairperson(s) will coordinate the sponsors and organize the event with assistance of other committee members, volunteers and staff.
- B. The Scholarship fund will be holding several fund raising events, PCCHA Awards Banquet, The Banquet Raffle, and the acquisitions of sponsorship donations, etc.
