## Open Cutting Stakes 1<sup>st</sup> Go Round

The Open Cutting Stakes is populated by a special class of horses, who are the progeny of the Subscribed Stallions. These foals of 2007 became eligible for this 2011 show. There is another division within the Cutting Stakes reserved for geldings only, and they show simultaneously for their advancement to the finals.

Saturday dawned to sunshine outside finally without the morning foggy drizzle. Inside the Event Center arena, horses and riders finished the last of 3 sets of the 5 sets of cattle for this section. Everyone thought that Phil Hanson on Mosa This Cats Black already had it in the bag marking a 222 in the 1st set on Friday. Mosa This Cats Black, a black mare, is by WR This Cats Smart, and out of a daughter of Travalena named Travalin Miss Mosa. She is owned by Jordan Miller of Lincoln, CA. Phil noted, "I've had her since February and just started showing her. " "I had a pretty good run today. She's a very talented mare. I just tried to cut some fairly soft cows. All 3 cows were in the middle. She was never out of position."

It wasn't until the 5th set, that things changed with the leaders. Clint Allen on Moms Stylish Cat matched Phil's 222 marking.

Moms Stylish Cat is by High Brow Cat and out of a daughter of Peptoboonsmal called Moms Stylish Pepto, and is owned by Jerry Durant. Clint said, "I've had him all along. He's won close to \$100,000, and I got 2nd in the Super Stakes on him." As far as today's run went, he added, it was good; good draw, clean run, horse was good, and cows were good."

Six horses later in the same herd, Phil Hanson bested his earlier work by 1 point, with a smokin' run on LHR Cattywampas marking 223, which put him in the leading spot coming out of the 1st Go Round of the Stakes. LHR Cattywampas is also by

High Brow Cat and out of Classic Jazabell, who is by Haidas San Badger. The sorrel gelding is owned by Bobbie Howe from Santa Ynez, CA. According to Phil, this talented gelding is a horse that Sherry Chamberlain raised, and now her daughter owns her. "She's done really well this year. She is a low headed, good stopping horse. The 1st two cows were good, but the 3rd cow was pretty tough. It felt like I had a tiny miss, but he handled it pretty good." This run also puts Phil and LHR Cattywampas in first position coming out of the 1st Go of the Gelding division of the Cutting Stakes.

When John landed in the U.S., he first lived in the El Centro area, which is where he met his wife Yvonne. This is where he still bases out of today. Yet, his rolling shop follows the circuits, where he provides a service to the cutters for their repairs and training needs.

John says he has sponsored the PCCHA shows for "a long time." "He felt like the Pacific Coast is where "I got my start. I wanted to give back. I try to sponsor the Association. The Pacific Coast was my grass roots. It's been a good symbiotic relationship."

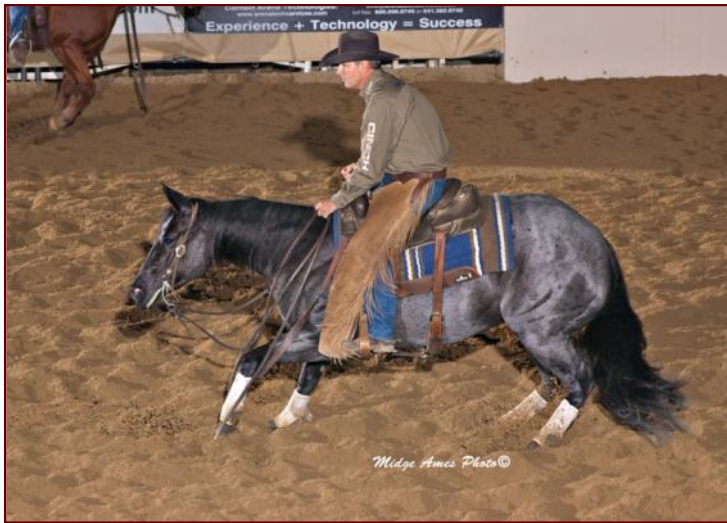

## Open Classic Challenge 2<sup>nd</sup> Go

Four sets of cattle filled with 49 horses competed for the honor of making the finals in the 5/6 year old Open Classic Challenge division. 14 horses plus ties will advance to the finals, and it took a score of 435.5 to advance out of the 2nd Go. The action got started very quickly in the 1st set with Lloyd Cox blasting out with an outstanding 223 marking on Little Lap Dancer, as the 2nd horse out. Little Lap Dancer, by Peptoboonsmal and out of Little Belly Dancer, by High Brow Hickory, is owned by Jimmy Kemp Jr. of Cisco, Texas. The blue roan mare looked eager and ready to get to work. Added to their 1st go score of 219, their total combined score leaped out for a lead that couldn't be broken. Lloyd said, "I got to ride Little Belly Dancer too." I trained her mostly (Little Lap Dancer) and I showed her the last couple of years. My 1st cow was just really good, and the 2nd one a little tougher I thought. The last cow got set up." He added that "she'll do good if I get her set up in the middle."

Just two horses later in the same set, Lloyd Cox did it again with another amazing 223 run

on a horse named Cat on a Mission, owned by John McLaren of McGregor, Texas. Cat on a Mission (High Brow Cat X Salute This who is a daughter of Smart Little Lena) is a sorrel stallion raised by John McLaren and who was originally trained by Mark Michaels. The first time Lloyd showed him was last year here in Paso Robles. About his run today, Lloyd remarked about the 1st cow, that "it was the best cow I've cut." Cat on a Mission's composite score is 439, putting him tied with another horse he was riding named Smart Stingrey (Dual Rey X Smart Sandhill by Smart Mate) also owned by John McLaren. Out of the top 5 composite scores coming out of the 2nd Go, Lloyd took 3 of the spots with Cat on a Mission and Smart Stingrey claiming the tied up 3rd position. He must have eaten his Wheaties today!

Two horses tied for the second position with total combined scores of 439.5 after today's runs. Fancy Lookin Cat (That Sly Cat X Plain N Fancy Peppy) ridden by John Mitchell of Weatherford, Texas is owned by Slate River Ranch, also of Weatherford, Texas. Fancy Lookin Cat scored a bright and clean 222 in this 2nd Go. Jaebars Angel (Smart Little Jaebars X Angels Little Gunner by Young Gun) was ridden by Cookie Banuelos to a smart 217.5 marking, which added nicely to his previous 222 of the 1st Go. The sorrel mare is owned by Kate and Cookie Banuelos of Las Vegas, Nevada.

The finals of the Open Classic Challenge are slated for Monday, October 24. Be here to watch the action!

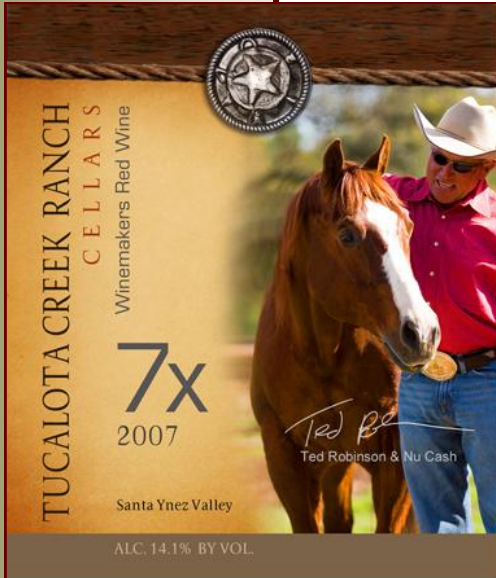
