

2010 Proposed PCCHA Aged Event Production Standards & Guidelines

The following "**Standards & Guidelines**, should be implemented whenever possible, if determined financially feasible¹ and conditions permitting.²

1. **Show Pen Setup** - To be setup using the old LA Futurity dimensions. (Dimensions on file with PCCHA Office & Randy Fenimore.)
2. **Practice Pens** - 2 main pens to be round (Dimensions on file). A 3rd & 4th pen to be setup in the Rodeo. ^{1 2}
3. **Schedule of Events** - Open go-rounds to be completed before Non-Pro and Amateur events start. ¹ **Open Finals & Semis**, (ie., Futurity, Cutting Stakes, Derby & Classic/Challenge) to be held at featured times during last 1, 2,3 days of event, in order to showcase events for; Corporate Sponsors, City of Paso Robles, Chamber of Commerce & Visitor's Bureau, and General Public.
4. **# of Cattle Per Entry** - 4 cows per-cutter (Open and Non-Pro) 3 cows per cutter Amateur division. Additional divisions to be determined on a per case basis. ¹
5. **Set sizes** - 12 horses per set. In Open & Non Pro Events, roll down to 11 if necessary, or up to 13. Never more than 13 unless approved by Event Production Committee Chairman.
6. **Number of sets per-day** – Recommend cutting run no longer than 10hrs per day (estimated @ 8 sets per day). ^{1 2}
7. **Main Loping Arena** - Ground to be worked regularly and sand added as needed.
8. **Lighting** - In Main Loping Arena after dark lights should be set at a level safe to for competitors to ride. Lights will be turned off at night when Facility Coordinator (Randy Fenimore) leaves the show grounds and turned on each morning by 5am.
9. **Additional Loping Area** – To be setup in Rodeo Arena, with a sand track laid for Futurity and/or as determined necessary by Event Production Committee Chairman. ^{1 2}
10. **Flag Cows** – 2 Flags to be setup at all events. ^{1 2} 1 Flag at South end of Main Loping arena and the other in the Rodeo Arena. Honor Sign-up System to be used. Sign up sheet/clipboard to left at entrance to Flag Cow Practice Area, trainers to self-monitor and enforce honor system.
11. **Security** – To be on site (Show Grounds & Trailer Parking Lots) from "dark to daylight," one day prior to event starting and throughout duration of event. ^{1 2}
12. **Equipment** - 2-3 Tractors* & 1 Water Truck, on site, in good repair and available for use as needed in; Show Arena, Main Loping Area and Rodeo Arena (*if available). ^{1 2}

Changes and/or additions to the above Standards & Guidelines; Must be processed as follows; 1) Requests & recommendation to be submitted to Event Production Committee Chairman. 2) Event Production Committee to review request and forward recommendations to Finance Committee. 3) Finance Committee to review recommendations for financial impact and forward results and their recommendations to Executive Committee. 4) Executive Committee to make final determination.
