Meeting Called to order by Chairman, Barbi Madgwick

2010 Youth Scholarship Distribution approved: Motion made by Megan Madgwick, Nancy Wilford seconded; motion passed.

Discussion: It was the consensus of the Committee to inquire with South Point and McArthur Cuttings to see if these shows would welcome a youth qualifier within their Summer Shows.

PCYCHA- Temporary Suspension of Association: Rhonda Benadum moved to suspend all functions of the PCYCHA for 2010 with a temporary "freeze" on \$4,400 that was transferred to the PCCHA Youth Fund; Megan Madgwick seconded; motion passed.

Discussion: Leading to the above decision was the present lack of involvement amongst the youth of the PCCHA. Any youth activities that are not connected to the normal Youth Fund events can be proposed casually and the Youth Committee will take the proposed event in consideration.

2010 PCCHA Youth Scholarship Auction: Barbie Madgwick and Rhonda Benadum will perform as Co-Chairwomen.

Rewards Point System: Nancy Wilford moved that the Youth Committee develop an "Incentive Point System" for PCCHA Youth members that will reward them for their efforts of involvement within their Association. The Committee will draw up a program and present it at the next scheduled meeting; Megan Madgwick seconded; Motion passed.

2010 Youth Cutting Clinic: The Youth Committee has asked David Booth to Approach David Costello and Bonnie Johnson on possibly providing a Youth Cutting Clinic in the Paso Robles area.

Clark Miller Sportsmanship Award:

David Booth moved to leave the current structure of the Clark Miller Hall of Fame/Sportsmanship award as is; Rhonda Benadum seconded; motion passed.

Discussion following motion: Lissa Miller requested that the Clark Miller Award be separated from the Hall of Fame as the intention of the Miller Family was to provide an award for a current Youth Member who deserves to be recognized for their sportsmanship.

Note: The committee discussed the concerns expressed by two PCCHA members regarding the Clark Miller before voting to leave the award as is. However the Youth Committee has appointed Kathy Cardon to Chair a Committee that will investigate the possibilities of restructuring this award to fit the Miller Family's request.

Youth Retreat: Lissa Miller suggested to the Youth Committee that the kids need an event where they can get to know each other better. Some ideas suggested were a branding; trip to the beach/BBQ or a 1 hour mixer at a cutting. The Youth Committee will continue to take suggestions and look for opportunities to execute these ideas during the year.
