## **PCCHA YOUTH POINTS SYSTEM**

Definition of Junior/Senior Divisions:

Junior: 13 yrs and younger Senior: 14-18 years of age As of Jan 1<sup>st</sup> each new year.

## Junior/Senior class- 6 or more entries

```
1<sup>st</sup> place= 6pts


2<sup>nd</sup> place= 5pts

3<sup>rd</sup> place= 4pts

4<sup>th</sup> place= 3pts

5<sup>th</sup> place= 2 pts

6<sup>th</sup> place= 1 pt
```



<u>3 or more entries</u> in a division, the class can be run alone or combined JR/SR but the points will be awarded separately:

4 Seniors

1st place= 4pts
2nd place= 3 pts
3rd place= 2 pts
4th place= 1 pt

5 Juniors

1st place= 5 pts
2nd place= 4 pts
2nd place= 4 pts
3rd place= 3 pts
4th place= 2 pts
5th place= 1pt

<u>Class of 6 youth- 2 Juniors/4 Seniors:</u> Since there are less than 3 entries in one age division, it does not constitute a class. Points are awarded on a combined basis, just like the pay out:

```
1<sup>st</sup> place= 6 pts

2<sup>nd</sup> place=5pts

3<sup>rd</sup> place=4pts

4<sup>th</sup> place=3pts

5<sup>th</sup> place=2pts

6<sup>th</sup> place=1 pt
```

The highest amount of points given are 6. If there are more than 6 entries, 1<sup>st</sup> place still gets 6 pts. If two horses have the same score, they get the same amount of points which will make the last point slot worth 2 pts.
