

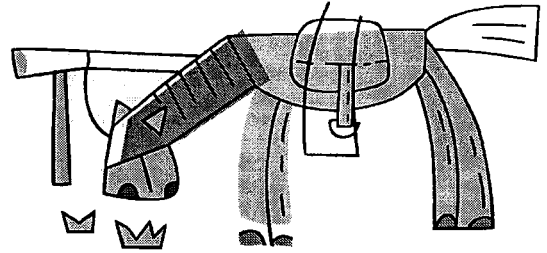
PCCHA YOUTH POINTS SYSTEM

Definition of Junior/Senior Divisions:

Junior: 13 yrs and younger

Senior: 14-18 years of age

As of Jan 1st each new year.



Junior/Senior class- 6 or more entries

1st place= 6pts

2nd place= 5pts

3rd place= 4pts

4th place= 3pts

5th place = 2 pts

6th place= 1 pt

3 or more entries in a division, the class can be run alone or combined JR/SR but the points will be awarded separately:

4 Seniors

1st place= 4pts

2nd place= 3 pts

3rd place= 2 pts

4th place= 1 pt

5 Juniors

1st place= 5 pts

2nd place= 4 pts

3rd place= 3 pts

4th place= 2 pts

5th place= 1pt

Class of 6 youth- 2 Juniors/4 Seniors: Since there are less than 3 entries in one age division, it does not constitute a class. Points are awarded on a combined basis, just like the pay out:

1st place= 6 pts

2nd place=5pts

3rd place=4pts

4th place=3pts

5th place=2pts

6th place=1 pt

The highest amount of points given are 6. If there are more than 6 entries, 1st place still gets 6 pts. If two horses have the same score, they get the same amount of points which will make the last point slot worth 2 pts.
